We are so excited to welcome our Hawks on campus this 2023-24 school year. With your help, we are bringing back and improving upon the IB programs that have allowed Hankey students to prosper and thrive in the classroom and our greater community.

What is CHIEF?

CHIEF is the Carl Hankey International Education Foundation, a 501c3 nonprofit organization (Tax ID #27-5248555) created to fund Hankey’s IB programs: elementary Spanish and middle school design. These programs are required by the IB World organization to qualify Hankey K-8 as an IB school- an education and curriculum that creates futures well-rounded leaders of the future.

The IB program at Hankey costs in excess of **\$50,000** per year and is self-funded by the Hankey community. CHIEF must fundraise approximately **\$125 per child** to ensure the continuation of our IB programs.

How can you help?

CHIEF has 3 fundraisers throughout the year to raise these funds: this direct donation campaign, the fall Hawk Trot, & our spring fundraiser. Through your support of these fundraisers, we can meet our annual goal.
